

# HOW TO GET TO THE DELTA HOTEL

## **FROM THE AIRPORT**

*The hotel does not provide a shuttle service.*

### **By Light Rail (c. 40-50 minutes): the slowest but one of the least expensive**

At the departures level inside the airport, look for the big sign for the O train; you can pay with a credit card (\$4.10). Trains run every 12 minutes.

Take the train to South Keys (the end of the short Line 4) and cross the platform to take Line 2 to Bayview (the end of Line 2). Go upstairs and take Line 1 east (towards Blair) two stops to Lyon. Look for the Lyon/Queen exit, and then just Lyon. The hotel is across the street from the entrance to the O train.

Pro-Tip: If you think you might use public transport during your stay, consider getting a Presto card ([octranspo.com](http://octranspo.com)) to use on the O train or buses. It costs \$4.00 and allows you to access senior rates (\$3.28). If you are a senior, you get free rides on Wednesday and Sunday. Do NOT add your Presto card to Apple Wallet or Google Wallet (or so says the website).

### **By Bus (c. 30-40 minutes): the other least expensive way, fewer transfers**

Take the express bus 105 (if you don't have a Presto card, pay with a credit card) to Hurdman, then transfer to the O train using the same credit card (you'll be charged just once for the entire trip). Take Line 1, going west to Tunney's Pasture and get off at Lyon. Look for the Lyon/Queen exit and then just Lyon. The hotel is across the street from the entrance to the O train.

### **By Taxi (c. 16 minutes):**

There is a taxi stand on the arrivals level. A taxi will cost c. \$30.

Pro-Tip: Uber and Lyft drivers are not unionized in Ottawa.

## **BY CAR**

Best to use GPS. The hotel (101 Lyon Street) is at the corner of Lyon and Queen on the western edge of downtown (called Centretown in Ottawa). Covered self-parking is \$25/day. Valet parking is \$35/day. Hourly parking is \$6.

There is off-site parking at 272 Queen St.

There is also a parking garage at 320 Queen St, with an entrance on Queen between Kent (one-way north) and Lyon (one-way south). Cost: c.\$3/30 min, \$20 daily, \$5 evenings and weekends.

## **FROM THE TRAIN STATION (VIA RAIL)**

### **By Light Rail (c. 10 minutes):**

The O Train entrance will be on your left as you exit the train station. The train costs \$4.10, and you can pay by credit card. Take the train west (towards Tunney's Pasture) to Lyon. Head for the Lyon/Queen exit, and then just Lyon. The hotel is across the street from the O train entrance.

Pro-Tip: If you think you might use public transport during your stay, consider getting a Presto card ([octranspo.com](http://octranspo.com)) to use on the O train or buses. It costs \$4.00 and allows you to access senior rates (\$3.28). Also reminder that you are a senior and therefore get free rides on Wednesday and Sunday. Do NOT add your Presto card to Apple Wallet or Google Wallet (or so says the website).

### **By Taxi (c. 15 minutes, depending upon traffic):**

Taxis will be waiting just outside the entrance to the train station. The cost (c.\$15.00) will depend upon the traffic.

Pro-Tip: Uber and Lyft drivers are not unionized in Ottawa.
